Abrahams Blessing is for You



Preparation Nugget: Prayer is only a piece of the puzzle in receiving God’s blessings. Prayer puts you in a position to hear from God and receive direction. It also provides you with an opportunity to speak God’s Word over your situation. However, you must also have the other pieces in place too. Knowing and doing are two different things. When you know what to do, be faithful to complete it. As you honor God, He will honor you.

Meditation on the Word: Faith begins where the will of God is known. Before praying, prepare yourself. Allow faith to rise up in your spirit as you meditate on the Word of God.

“Now the Lord said to Abram, ‘Go from your country and your kindred and your father’s house to the land that I will show you. And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.’” Genesis 12:1-3 ESV

“...in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we might receive the promised Spirit through faith.” Galatians 3:14 ESV

Nugget of Truth: Abraham is called the “Father of Nations.” He is the most well known Bible person throughout the world, especially in the Middle East. Abraham was called a “friend of God.” He was blessed in every area: physically, financially and spiritually. Financially he was very rich.¹ We are heirs to the promises of Abraham.²

God’s purpose in blessing you is so that you will be a blessing. Like Abraham, we must learn to GO when God says GO. Obedience is always better than sacrifice. When you and I trust Him, we realize that He sees things from a different perspective. He knows the end result as well as the present condition. Now, why wouldn’t we want to do what He says to do? What good reason could we possibly have to refuse His direction? None.

As we listen and obey God, we can always be assured that HE WILL SHOW YOU. What is it that He will show you? Whatever you need to see! Trust Him.

Always remember the HE WILL MAKE YOU great. It’s important that we stay humble and recognize that everything we are or hope to be is because of Jesus.

The rewards are always obvious: HE WILL BLESS YOU. What a thought. God will bless me! He loves you and He loves me. He will never leave you or forsake you. 24-hours a day He is here for you. That’s something to get excited about!

Abraham listened to God, and God blessed and prospered him. He learned the spiritual principles of prosperity firsthand. God wanted to be involved in Abraham’s finances, and He wants to be involved in yours³. Some of the fundamental principles of Abraham’s prosperity include:

1. He listened to and obeyed God. (Gen. 12:1-4)
2. He honored God, who prospered him. (Gen. 12:7)
3. He was generous and avoided strife. (Gen. 13:5-9)
4. He was compassionate toward others. (Gen. 18: 24-33)

If you want God to be involved in your finances and prosper you, you must honor these basic principles too.
